

*HoofDoctor* is designed for use in footbaths to help prevent the incidence of hairy heel wart. It is part of the overall management program for foot health.

Hooves should be trimmed or inspected twice annually.

High concentrate diets should be fed with care.

Cows should spend limited time standing on concrete.

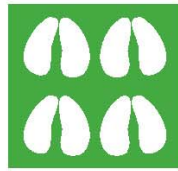
Cows should not be rushed when walking on any abrasive surface: consider installing rubber mats in cow walkways.

Cows should have a clean, easily accessible comfortable area to lay down in.

Lame cows should be identified and treated as early as possible.

If cases of hairy heel warts exist, consult your veterinarian re. an appropriate antibiotic treatment program. Augment this with external treatment with a topical antibiotic or by spraying with a 10% solution of *HoofDoctor*.

Daily year-round use of *HoofDoctor* in footbaths should be started immediately.

**Footbath Concentrate to Help in Control of Hairy Heel Warts**

## Directions for use:

*HoofDoctor* should be added to footbaths at ½ gallon per 50 gallons of footbath (1% solution). Minimum footbath depth should be 5 inches.

Place footbath in return alley, not in parlor. Wash dirt and manure off of the cow's feet prior to walking through the footbath.

The *HoofDoctor* footbath prepared as above is effective for 800 cow passes per day. Check footbath depth and condition (manure level) approximately every two hundred cows. Maintain a "top off" solution (½ pint *HoofDoctor* made up to five gallons with water) and add to footbath to maintain the correct footbath depth.

Use a footbath following each milking to help condition hoof tissue and prevent hairy heel wart and other hoof infections.

Change the footbath after 800 cows have passed through it. Prolonged use without change may increase the risk of foot lesions.

Keep *HoofDoctor* container closed and avoid contact with other farm chemicals.

*HoofDoctor* is biodegradable and may be disposed of to slurry handling system, in accordance with local regulations.
